

A model based on the Diablo I with three parameters changed to provide more control over the board and verticality in maneuvers. Designed for the same wave range as its predecessor. For intermediate to advanced surfers. This model is only made with a round tail

The Soul Bigfoot is one of the most popular "high performance" short and wide boards in the range among intermediate and advanced surfers.

This board is used up to 4 inches shorter than usual and is also wider and with less rocker than a traditional shortboard. It features a wing towards the tail ending in a diamond tail, which shortens the rail and makes the board feel looser. Medium depth concaves, with single to double concave, with full rails to give the board the volume it needs.

The board accelerates quickly and maintains speed in turns, allowing you to link maneuvers effortlessly. Generally, this board is used by intermediate or advanced surfers in small to medium waves.

The Soul TNT is a high-performance board for small waves. A flat rocker with a lifted curve in the rail gives speed and looseness to the back of the board.

A chunky outline combined with a wide round squash tail allows for fast rail-to-rail surfing. This combination becomes so magical that it is a model used in competitions by good surfers.

Designed to be used 3 inches shorter than your height.

The Soul Delocos model is a surfboard with a wide fish-style tail but designed with a round square tail.

The board's design features a low to medium nose rocker, medium to low tail rocker with a deep single concave right in the tail area.

The rail is low and soft combined with a slightly flatter deck. We have added a 5-fin system to create different sensations when ridden as a thruster or quad. It is very fast on the wave and goes vertical, maintaining speed in tight turns and takes off very well.




The perfect board for smaller, weaker waves. Whether you come from longboards or shortboards, this model will make you feel like you have a flying carpet under your feet. Flat rocker in the nose and a good rocker in the tail for tight turns without losing speed in maneuvers.

Much of its secret lies in the combination of the bottom and rails. It can be used as a trifin for the more radical surfers or as a quad for extra grip and security. "A good option for this model is to make the tail in swallow as it will reduce some nervousness when doing more powerful surfing, as well as adding a fifth stabilizer fin to the quad."

There is extra area in the nose to help you paddle into smaller waves as well as those weak sections. Its double winger decreases the width in the tail and provides a pivot point for top-to-bottom surfing.

The Soul Alchemist is the perfect balance between a small wave board and a high-performance shortboard.




A model inspired by our "best seller" Stumpy, with a modified nose width to help with paddling and combined with a round tail for greater maneuverability.

This board meets all the expectations of any surfer and wave size.


The design came from widening the outline of a contemporary shortboard, resulting in a very fast planing speed. The low nose rocker provides acceleration and ease of paddling, while the performance-style tail rocker allows the board to go vertical and agile when needed.

It has a single concave throughout the board with a decent double concave under the back foot, making it easy to go from rail to rail.

The Soul Mutant is best described as a 'high-performance hybrid' and should be ridden at least two inches shorter than your standard high-performance shortboard.




The Soul Bull Head is designed for surfing in all types of conditions with a retro style shape but high performance in waves from 2 to 5 feet. The more rounded nose shape with a wide rounded tail facilitates good glide when paddling for an easy takeoff and transition to standing. Somehow, it remains a performance board with easy speed down the line, flows well in turns, and is great for roundhouse cutbacks and off-the-top turns. It can be surfed in a relaxed style or surfed hard with power turns. It works well in beach, point, and reef breaks.

The nose area and the tail area are similar to a high-performance shortboard. It has a single to double concave with low rocker in the nose and medium rocker in the tail. The rails are slightly thicker, with a beak-style nose and a slightly thicker tail.

Soul The Magnet was created after working with our Portuguese rider team on a new board that maintained high performance in average conditions.

The Magnet has a wide outline and more volume than a standard board, subtly hidden throughout.

The bottom goes from a slight concave to a double concave, helping The Magnet surf in average conditions, which will be most days...

But you can also use it on those perfect, larger days... It's a true all-rounder. It comes with a three-fin setup but can be ordered with five plugs.

This model comes with a standard round square tail but can also be ordered with a round or swallow tail.

The Soul Zero retains all the elements of the Zero range, with a low rocker that makes it glide like a dream, with a slight increase in nose rocker and sharpening for quick direction changes, especially in the curvier sections of small waves.


One of the main design changes is a single concave ending in a V in the swallow tail, making it quite versatile in more powerful sections while maintaining maneuverability. This is also due to its central rocker line, for which the Zero range is known. It has a generous volume distribution throughout the deck, ending in a slightly tapered rail that forgives mistakes while providing sensitivity and directional control, essential for surfing small and hollow waves.



This is one of the models we have spent the most time developing in terms of design because we wanted to combine comfort, versatility, and performance.

A board with a slightly wider outline than a conventional shortboard and a forward wide point. A moderate rocker starting from the center helps with paddling and planing, generating good speed, combined with a kick tail (rocker at the tail) providing maneuverability and verticality in turns.

The volume is well-distributed throughout the board but without excess, allowing early wave entry, combined with a medium rail for the necessary grip to perform good maneuvers.

Suitable for intermediate to advanced surfers and all types of conditions.

The bottom features a shallow single to double concave ending with a Vee in the rear. The result is a board ideal for high-performance rail-to-rail surfing at high speeds. The low rail allows the board to roll on the rail without struggling to maintain control and provides tons of drive.

The Soul Surfboards Budha is not your typical "Retro"; it's a high-performance surfboard with the positive aspects of a Retro fish design. This board will make you eager to get out there every day in a variety of conditions. Budha is the perfect summer board for your local beachie, and it performs well in point breaks too. Evolving from the minimalibu, the Evolution model has a narrower, more pointed nose that provides an additional step when starting to link turns and can be used on waves with a bit more verticality in the wall.

Although it has always been a model associated with learning, in the hands of experienced surfers, this model will offer you an extra edge when the peak is more crowded than usual or to bring out all your flow in long rides.



The Soul Big Step offers you the possibility of using a shorter and more maneuverable board in larger waves. With this model, we added width in the nose and more volume towards the front to compensate for the shorter length.

We recommend going 1 to 3 feet shorter than your typical Gun while adding 1/2" to the width and 1/2" to the thickness. With the combination of a wider nose, a thicker volume flow, and a smooth entry rocker, this model will take you to almost everything the ocean has to offer. By going shorter, the Soul Big Step allows the surfer to maneuver their board, unlike the large Guns of the past that only allowed surfers to make the drop. We recommend opting for a quad fin setup to offer the fastest fin configuration possible. This will help in the tube, overcome large sections, and maneuver the board well in larger sizes.

This board is a reliable beast and holds the line well.
